One-Year PGY1 Residency Program In a Community Pharmacy Setting

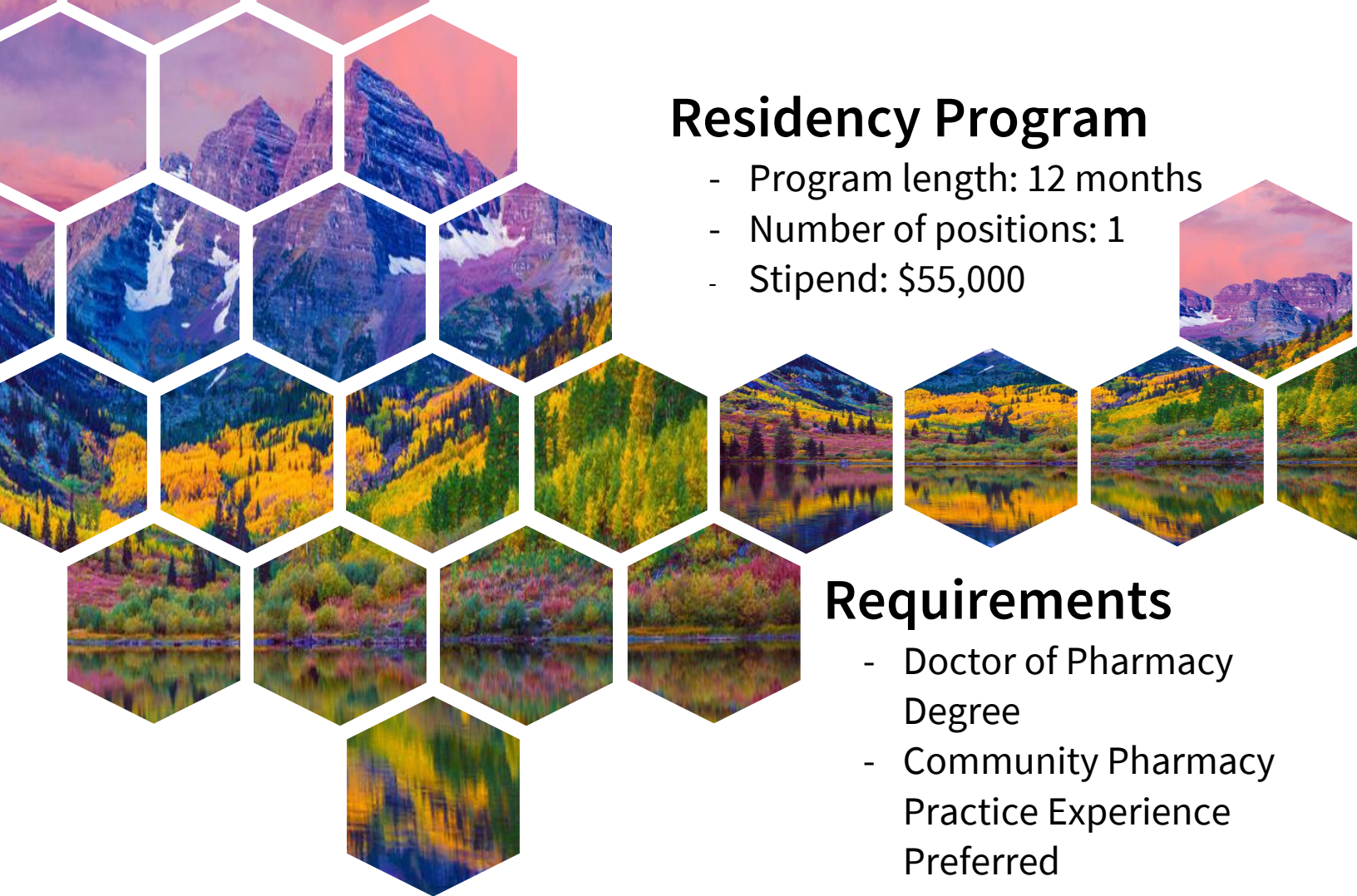

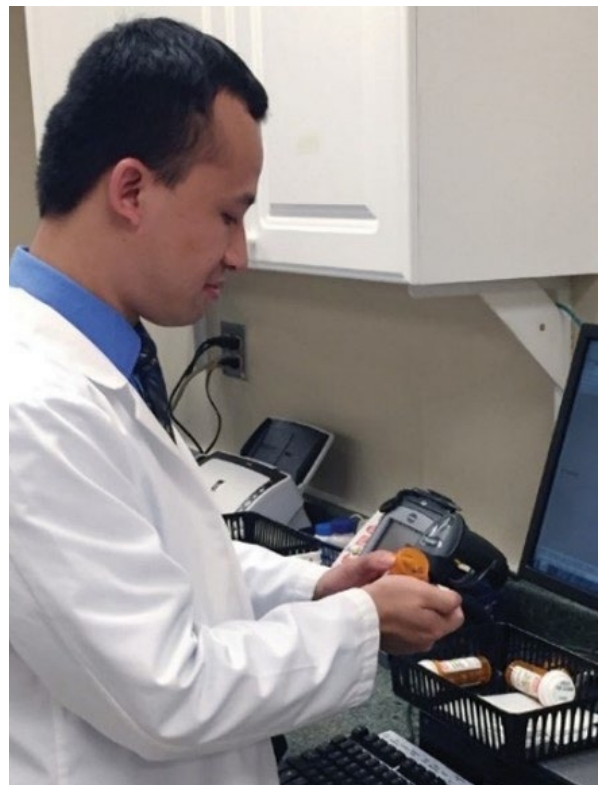
ABOUT KING SOOPERS
