

November 2020 Distance Degree Programs (DDP) Committee Report

Major topics and accomplishments are listed below:

September 8th Meeting:

- New committee charges were reviewed. Committee voted to approve the new charges. New charges were sent to Dr. David Thompson.
- The revised course PRDO 7800 Clinical Reasoning and Decision Making was reviewed and approved by the committee. This course is now being taught by Drs. Blackmer and Jeffres to be in line with what is taught in the entry-level curriculum.
- A new elective course to be offered in DDP Fall 2020 - PRDO 7818 Pharm Industry Fundamentals was reviewed and approved by the committee.

September 22nd Meeting:

- The new DPP Honors Project program for NTPD and ITPD Committee was presented to the committee. The program was voted on and approved by the committee.
- An update to the APPE Rotation policy for the ITPD program was presented. It was sent out for email vote and was approved.

October 20th Meeting:

- Two admission applicant issues were discussed, and votes were taken as appropriate.
- An update to the APPE Rotation policy for NTPD was presented. No vote was needed.
- An update to the Admission Policy- English Language was presented. The wording change was voted on and approved by the committee.

November 3rd Meeting:

- Three admission applicant issues were discussed, and votes were taken as appropriate.
- The Technical Requirement Policy is to be updated to be in line with the Entry-level program. The changes will be sent out for an email vote.
